Is research required if I am majoring in psychology?	As a psychology major, research experience is recommended to take advantage of during your undergraduate years especially if you plan to apply for grad school later.

Generally, students can take advantage of student employment on-campus if you qualify for work-study on your fafsa application that you submitted in March. You can check out oncampus job posts on "Handshake." You can find Handshake on your R'Web Student Portal.

Can I get into the Honors program if I'm a transfer student?	Yes, transfer students can get involved with the Honors Program if you meet their specific requirements. Check out their webpage, for more detailed information, https://honors.ucr.edu/.
When do we get an ID card? Or is our net ID our school ID?	You can find your School ID if you navigate to your R'Web. The easiest way to locate it is to click the Student Profile icon. There you will see all your student info.
I take hormones. Does UCR have a pharmacy, and would I be able to pick them up at the pharmacy?	Are you referring to HRT?

Does Expected Transfer Date mean the term you will enroll to the UC campus?	That is indicating your expected date to transfer.
Will there be a course description code to highlight which classes are online versus in-person?	When you get access to a registration ticket you will be able to navigate the system to look up classes. Each class with indicate whether the class will be "online" or in-person (usually will show the building and room number). Along with the course number, you could even just type in the name of the course and it will pop up with details.
For the orientation, do we receive a link to join it? I already registered for orientation, but I didn't receive any link or email confirmation. However, on the website I registered, on the right corner (underlined), it says "Jump to Transfer Orientation." I'm assuming I have to click there couple minutes before the orientation. I'm just afraid it won't work since it didn't give me a link like we get for zoom meetings. Do we still get a link couple days before the orientation?
