What percentage of the undergraduate students graduate with a job or graduate school?	Before someone else answers the question with the actual answer, I'll give my personal input and insight. I truly believe and have seen, that if you keep up decent grades, get involved in orgs and projects, make some connections, you are pretty much guaranteed a good job out after graduating. If you just go to class and not much else, you can expect it to be tougher when competing against students from prestigious schools.
Are all students from pre-business accepted into Business program, as long as they meet the academic requirements?	From my experience as long as the student fulfills the requirements needed to apply they are accepted into the program!
Is the school of business intertwined with the mathematics/statistics classes at Olmsted Hall?	Although students will take stats classes located in Olmsted, the School of Business is not intertwined with those classes.

<p>Is this information also applicable to business/econ majors?</p>	<p>Business administration and business economics are two different major and our course work does not overlap. The information in this session is specifically for Business Administration.</p>
<p>Do we have room to take multiple electives related to our non-business interests even while completing all the other upper division requirements?</p>	<p>In my experience, yes!</p>
<p>What is the MAE? What happens if we get a bad score in it? Can we retake it?</p>	<p>The MAE is the math placement exam that is required to be taken to be placed into the correct math course. For those who have taken AP math classes you may not have to take the MAE depending on the score received. The score of the MAE exam will correlate to the math class that you will be placed in when entering UCR (or if you happen to place out of math). In regards to retaking the exam more than once, I would contact the MAE test center to see if that is possible!</p>
<p>Is business econ not housed in the School of Business?</p>	<p>Business econ is a seperate major from business administration and therefore it is not housed under the School of Business due to the requirements being different without any overlap.</p>

<p>What is Business Analytics?</p>	<p>Business analytics is a specific concentration that is under the business administration major.</p>
<p>What is the major you are accepted in to in the pre-business program?</p>	<p>You are a pre-business student until you are accepted into the school of business. From then, you are a business major until you choose a concentration.</p>
<p>When do we take to MAE or start taking it?</p>	<p>For the MAE, there are typically various dates ranging from May-July. These dates are typically found within the testing website and appointments can be made through there!</p>
<p>When I turned in my SIR i switched my major to pre-business was there any specific requirements I had to meet ?</p>	<p>If you have applied for a major change through your portal, you will need to follow up with the office of admission.</p>

<p>Can we do 2 concentrations for Business Admin?</p>	<p>You can only declare one concentration but you can take your upper division electives in any concentration you would like.</p>
<p>What is the difference between a BA vs BS in Business Administration?</p>	<p>We only offer a BS in Business which means a Bachelors of Science as opposed to a BA, Bachelors of Arts.</p>
<p>How easy is it for a student to change their major. For example, if they want to switch their major from business to Psychology. Thanks</p>	<p>This is going to depend on what major and when you decide to make the change. Some major at UCR are very selective and so changing your major may not be as easy.</p>
<p>So with a business admin major you can't take a business minor right?</p>	<p>Minors need to be in a department outside of your major.</p>

Are there plans to go back in person in the fall?	At this time, the campus is optimistic about a Fall return and is planning in accordance to state and city restrictions. We will have more updates on the plan over the summer.
For different majors within business are there different prerequisites?	Yes, some concentrations will have specific course requirements that may not be required by other concentrations. Examples include Finance and Accounting.
What general GE's are relevant to this major path?	When in PRBS you have to take your GE's and Business prep courses. You will have a chance to go over these with your PRBS advisor.
Is changing to Psychology difficult?	You will need to meet with and adviser in the Psychology department to determine this. If you are considering the change prior to enrollment, you should submit your request through your admission portal.

Is an MAE required?	Given that you must complete Calculus as part of the requirements for admission, you will likely need to take the placement exam in mathematics. exceptions may be if you have AP credit.
Will we have any chances to take courses during our "pre-bus" to help us know which concentration we would like to choose?	Once you meet the prerequisites for upper division courses in Business, you can begin exploring the CORE business classes which are meant to introduce you to the seven concentrations.
If I want to open up my own business, where would I fall under? Marketing? Finance?	Management, Entrepreneurship track.
When/what year do we declare our business concentration?	At this time, we do not have an official time to declare, but we recommend that you declare your concentration at least by the end of your junior year.

<p>Is data sci a concentration in the school of business?</p>	<p>Information Systems would be the closest we have to that.</p>
<p>Is Business Economics part of the pre-business program?</p>	<p>No, this major is housed in CHASS.</p>
<p>What kind of math courses do business admin majors have to take?</p>	<p>You must complete Business Calculus or Calculus A &amp; B through CNAS.</p>
<p>Some schools have business affiliations /programs where they have positions looking for students from specific schools. Does ucr have anything like that?</p>	<p>Yes, we do through our career center! We have a great career center on campus.</p>

What's the difference between a regular calculus course and business calculus?	The calculus A/B series is meant for students in Science and Math so it will be slightly more rigorous.
Has there been any notable internship available to undergrads in the gaming industry?	I personally knew one of my friends who got an internship at Blizzard Entertainment before her senior year!
How difficult is it to change from Business Economics to Business Administration, pre-business, in your freshman year?	Once you are a student on campus, you will have to individually discuss with each department your major change options.
To the student ambassadors: what are your own personal experiences with internships and work experience during college?	For my personal experience I was able to find an internship last summer related to marketing! There are a lot of resources available to help students look for internships and jobs and definitely a lot of people that are willing to help!



What's information systems?	Info systems focuses on helping organization leverage technology in order to create or sustain a competitive advantage.
Are there any internships connected to fashion for undergrads that are applicable through a business major?	Yes.
