Do we have to keep the 3.25 to remain eligible, or does it go up once we are accepted?	Yes, University Honors students must maintain a 3.25 GPA at UCR to remain in University Honors.
Hello! If we are not invited, does that mean we do not meet the criteria?	In general, yes. However, if you think you might be eligible, you are welcome to email <a href="mailto:lourdes.maldonado@ucr.edu">lourdes.maldonado@ucr.edu</a> with your UCR application ID, and she will check on your eligibility.
I am a transfer student and I have submitted my application, how soon should I receive a response?	Decisions will be sent in late-May.

<p>Can we take the required course during the summer quarter as well?</p>	<p>University Honors courses are not offered during the summer, but it may be possible for you to take other classes during the summer.</p>
<p>If your applying as an freshman to the Honors program, when will you be notified of admission?</p>	<p>First-year applicants are in the process of being notified.</p>
<p>How much is the HEIR Scholarship for?</p>	<p>Up to \$1,000 per student.</p>
<p>Are study abroad and honors program plausible for transfers students to participate in both?</p>	<p>Absolutely.</p>

<p>Will being an commuter affect my chances to be accepted for Honors? Since I will not be living on/near campus.</p>	<p>Absolutely not. Several University Honors students are commuters, and you are welcome to spend time in the Honors Office in between your classes.</p>
<p>If I take summer courses can those count towards my GPA for my application into the Honors program?</p>	<p>No, your GPA for eligibility is based solely on your UCR application.</p>
<p>Can we still apply for University Honors for fall 2021?</p>	<p>Possibly. There will be a second wave of applications in mid-June.</p>
<p>So my GPA would be the one in my final transcripts ending spring semester ? How can I know my UC GPA?</p>	<p>If you contact Lourdes via email, she can check for you.</p>

<p>If you are in a community college now and haven't got a highschool diploma, (doing high school and college at the same time) would you still be considered as a transfer student instead of a freshman?</p>	<p>University Honors defers to the status to which you were accepted to UCR, either as a first-year student or a transfer student.</p>
<p>What are the differences between the LLC and University Honors programs?</p>	<p>An LLC is a living-learning community, which means that students live in a common residence hall. University Honors has an LLC, but also offers many programs separate from the LLC.</p>
