Guarantee Your Admission: TAG to UCR

Enroll in the Transfer Admission Guarantee (TAG) program. Submit your UCR application and apply for your contracted major and term by:

MAY 1-31	TAG filing period for winter. Admissions application filing period: July 1–31
SEP 1-30	TAG filing period for fall. Admissions application filing period: November 1–30

Students who complete the following are admitted to UCR:

Breadth Requirements – Complete the Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) or the UCR breadth pattern for CHASS.

Prerequisites – Visit [ASSIST.org](https://assist.org) to view the prerequisites needed for your intended major (and to make sure your classes will transfer).

Minimum GPA – Strive to surpass the 2.4 minimum GPA and the 2.7 minimum GPA for psychology.
