How to Get into Your Major

Students who complete the following are admitted to UCR:

Breadth Requirements – Complete the Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) or the UCR breadth pattern for CHASS.

Prerequisites – Visit <u>ASSIST.org</u> to view the prerequisites needed for your intended major (and to make sure your classes will transfer).

Minimum GPA – Strive to surpass the overall 2.4 minimum GPA and the 2.7 minimum GPA for psychology.
