



Out-of-State Transfer Admission Checklist

Prepare for UC Riverside

Senior Year of High School

August–December

- Consider your transfer options.
- Visit transfer.ucr.edu to learn more about UCR transfer admission, majors we offer and how you will be supported.
- Visit financialaid.ucr.edu to explore your financial aid options.
- Plan your college finances with your family.

January–February

- Visit fafsa.ed.gov to apply for financial aid annually, between **Oct. 1** and **March 2**. UCR's school code: FAFSA (001316)
- Receive your Student Aid Report via mail or email confirming receipt of your FAFSA.

March–April

- Apply for admission to the community college or university of your choice. Most operate on a semester system, but deadlines vary.
- Take the math and writing assessment.
- Meet with a counselor and express your interest in transferring to UCR. Develop a transfer plan including English and math courses that meet minimum UC eligibility and UCR selection requirements.
- Plan to enroll in a college career guidance course.

First Year of Community College or University

August

- Research your major at admissions.ucr.edu. Identify prerequisites and the minimum GPA as some majors are selective.

September–December

- Contact a UCR counselor to develop an education plan specific to UCR and your desired major. Visit admissions.ucr.edu/transfer to schedule a transfer appointment.
- Visit go.ucr.edu/tap to create a Transfer Admission Planner (TAP) account.

October–January

- Visit fafsa.ed.gov to apply for financial aid annually (**between Oct. 1 and March 2**). UCR's school codes: FAFSA (001316) and DREAM (00136)
- Participate in extracurricular activities and internships.

March–August

- Complete 30 transferable semester units by the **end of summer**.
- Plan to complete 60 transferable semester units (90 quarter units) by the **end of the next spring term**.
- Plan to meet all prerequisites for your major.

Out-of-State Transfer Admission Checklist

Second Year of Community College or University

August

- Start working on your application! Access your UC undergraduate application for admission **Aug. 1** at <http://admission.universityofcalifornia.edu/>

September

- Meet with a UCR counselor to ensure you are on target with your transfer plan.
- Go to visit.ucr.edu to schedule a campus tour or view a wide selection of virtual tours.

November

- Apply to UCR! Submit your UC undergraduate application for admission online from **Nov. 1–30**.
- Add UCR Undergraduate Admissions to your email safe list. All messages will be sent to the address listed on your application.

December

- Visit go.ucr.edu/apply to check your UC application status.
- Complete fall courses at your community college or university, making sure to maintain/improve your GPA.

January–February

- Apply for financial aid annually, between **October 1 and March 2**, at fafsa.ed.gov (UCR code is 001316).
- Complete the Transfer Academic Update at universityofcalifornia.edu/admissions/appupdate by the priority deadline of **Jan. 31**.
- Visit housing.ucr.edu to explore campus apartments and family housing.
- Notify UCR Undergraduate Admissions of any changes in your planned course work.

March

- Notify UCR Undergraduate Admissions of any changes to your academic plan and/or any D or F grades you receive during spring term.
- Admission notifications begin **March 1**. Visit My.UCR.EDU to check your admission status through your MyUCR account.

April–June (If admitted):

- Submit your Statement of Legal Residence (SLR) online by **May 15**.
- Submit your Statement of Intent to Register (SIR) by **June 1**.

July

- Submit official transcripts to UCR Undergraduate Admissions by **July 1**.
- Submit all other requested supporting documents to UCR Undergraduate Admissions by **July 15**.

August

- Register to attend Highlander Orientation for Transfers by **Aug. 1**. Visit transferorientation.ucr.edu for details.

Winter Applications

July

- UCR is open for winter applications from **July 1–31**. Plan to apply if you will be completing 60 semester (90 quarter) units by the **end of fall term**.

August

- Complete the Transfer Academic Update at universityofcalifornia.edu/admissions/appupdate by **Sept. 15**.

Early September

- Admission notifications begin in September. Check your admission status at My.UCR.EDU

October

- Submit your Statement of Intent to Register (SIR) by **Oct. 15**.

November

- Submit official transcripts to UCR Undergraduate Admissions with final grades through summer 2018 by **Nov. 1**.

January

- Submit official transcripts to UCR Undergraduate Admissions with final grades through fall 2018 by **Jan. 15**.
