

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR FIRST YEAR

Subject Requirement

Get a grade C or better in all college preparatory ("a–g") courses. Complete a minimum of 15 "a–g" courses and finish 11 courses before your senior year.

GPA Requirement

Get a 3.0 or higher (3.4 for non-residents) in "a–g" courses taken during grades 10 and 11, weighted by a max of 8 semesters of UC-approved honors points.

UCR is Test-Free for Fall 2024

UC Riverside will not consider SAT or ACT scores for admission or scholarship purposes through fall 2024. If you choose to submit test scores as part of your application, they may be used as an alternative method of fulfilling minimum requirements for eligibility or for course placement after you enroll. Details regarding UC's testing policy can be found online.





ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR TRANSFER

UC Admission Requirements

- Complete 60 semester (90 quarter) units of transferable college credit.
- Earn a minimum GPA of 2.4 (CA residents) or 2.8 (non-residents).
- Complete (grade C or better) the following by the end of spring term prior to transfer: o 2 courses in English Composition

 - 1 course in Mathematical Concepts & Quantitative Reasoning

Take College Breadth (General Education) Courses

- Not required for admission.
- Gives you more freedom when selecting UCR courses; helps you graduate on time.


