- After workgroup members introduced themselves, Dr. Myrick reviewed the charge for the Black Student Experience Workgroup (BSEWG) 2.0.
- Dr. Myrick reviewed a brief history and outcomes of the original BSEWG; explained key areas of its <u>report</u>; and highlighted points of distinction from other campus workgroups that may have a similar name or composition.
 - With support from campus leadership, including Chancellor Wilcox, VCSA Brian Haynes, and Interim Provost Thomas Smith, the second iteration of the BSEWG was created.
 - BSEWG 2.0 members will work to implement approved recommendations and carry out other aspects of the group's charge.
 - **o** BSEWG 2.0 members are asked to review the report.
- The structure and groundwork for BSEWG 2.0. were discussed and attendees received a brief overview of the shared drive.
 - Prior to this first 2.0 meeting, efforts were made to facilitate the work of the group, including:
 - Carrying out nominations
 - Obtaining input from campus/community leaders regarding implementation and collaboration
 - Prioritizing recommendations and determining a timeline
 - Creating a shared drive
 - Scheduling monthly BSEWG 2.0 meetings



- Shonte Thomas discussed subcommittees and presented an implementation timeline.
 - Recommendations are prioritized based on urgency and feasibility in light of factors such as COVID-19.
 - BSEWG will work with Undergraduate Admissions (UGA) to implement recommendations, as a number of the recommended actions relate to this area.
 - There is a possibility of adding an additional subcommittee or subcommittees as needed.
- There was a group discussion regarding matters related to BSEWG 2.0.
 - Shonte Thomas noted that the charge of the BSEWG 2.0 includes building inclusive and positive environments for Black student success and holistic well-being; the work of the <u>Campus Safety Task</u> <u>Force</u> (CSTF) is related to the BSEWG 2.0 in this aspect.
 - It is suggested that BSEWG 2.0 members review the CSTF <u>report</u> and the group may provide feedback regarding the CSTF in the future.
 - Members discussed accountability; obtaining resources and support within the campus community; and ways to ensure recommendations of the BSEWG are implemented in a timely manner.
 - It is noted that the University of California Undergraduate Experience Survey (<u>UCUES</u>) has student data that may be relevant to the work of the BSEWG 2.0.
 - Tri-chairs will continue discussions regarding sending a declaration to the campus announcing the work of the BSEWG 2.0., its membership/leadership, and other relevant information. Plans are to send the declaration during the first week in March. It is noted that tri-chairs sought to meet as a collective prior to sending the declaration.
 - Allura Davis noted that due to a significant number of approved recommendations for UGA, the department has discussed forming a committee for this matter. She asked if this is an agreeable approach in terms of the BSEWG 2.0. Shonte Thomas agreed with the approach.

Additional Actions Items

- Shonte Thomas will send an email to the BSEWG 2.0 that allows members to select a subcommittee.
- The email will also include a question about accountability and what that would look like. Plans are to include some of this language in the declaration.
