



You have the right to:

## MAKE A POLICE REPORT

- Accompaniment during the police interview.
- Obtain a copy of your police report.
- Protect your name from public disclosure.
- Request information about DNA testing, forensic exam and crime evidence.



## GET MEDICAL ATTENTION

- A free forensic medication examination to gather evidence.
- Accompaniment during the medical examination.



## PARTICIPATE IN LEGAL PROCEEDINGS

- Accompaniment during interviews with the district attorney(s).
- Accompaniment during interviews with the attorney(s) for the defendant.
- Notifications of a plea agreement.
- Witness fees and mileage reimbursement.
- Time off from work to testify.
- Keep your name, address and telephone number confidential.
- Attend court proceedings.
- Accompaniment during court proceedings.
- Protect information about your sexual history.



## BE INFORMED OF LEGAL PROCEEDINGS

- Attend sentencing proceedings.
- Make a victim impact statement.
- Information about the outcome of the case.
- To be notified of the release, escape, recapture or death of the offender.
- Notification of special conditions on the offender's parole.
- Notification regarding parole hearings.
- Attend parole hearings.
- Accompaniment during the parole hearing.



## RECEIVE RESTITUTION

- Reimbursement from the California Victim Compensation Program.
- Court-ordered restitution from the offender.
- Civil recovery



### MAKE A TITLE IX REPORT

Those individuals who choose to make a report to the university are entitled to:

- Opt out of the process anytime.
- Make statements, produce witnesses/evidence and share personal impact.
- Have a learning environment free from retaliation for reporting violence or participating in a report.
- Receive timely case updates and notice for meetings.
- Anticipate a timely resolution after a complaint is filed with UCR (60 business days for investigation and adjudication, 60 days for appeal).
- To request a copy of the investigation report.

A CARE advocate can accompany you to any appointments, interviews and court proceedings throughout the process.
