## **NEW STUDENTS to SDRC Checklist**

### **Checklist for SDRC Registration and Accommodation(s) Approval**

**R'Ability Online System:** Register, Request and Access Accommodations via <https://rability.ucr.edu>  
Review *Training materials on how to use R'ability* at <http://SDRC.ucr.edu>

- 1. Online Pre-Registration - Self-identify:** Go to the R'Ability Website at <https://rability.ucr.edu>, click on the **Student Portal**, log-on, select **Online Pre-Registration** option to:
  - ✓ Self-identify as a student with a disability,
  - ✓ Request registration with SDRC, and
  - ✓ Submit/upload available disability related documentation (including medical condition diagnosis) at **least (2) weeks prior** to the start of services being requested (documentation guidelines are available at [www.sdrc.ucr.edu](http://www.sdrc.ucr.edu) ; or by emailing [sdrc@ucr.edu](mailto:sdrc@ucr.edu)).
  
- 2. Schedule INTAKE appointment after you complete the Online Pre-Registration:**
  - ✓ Call (951) 827-3861 or email [sdrc@ucr.edu](mailto:sdrc@ucr.edu) to schedule an INTAKE appointment with a Disability Specialist
  - ✓ SDRC staff will review documentation and determine if further information is needed
  - ✓ If Verification of Disability is not available, and you are inquiring about services, we do have INFORMATIONAL appointments available
  
- 3. Attend INTAKE appointment to meet with a Disability Specialist** at the SDRC to discuss the accommodations or services you may be eligible to receive. Note: if your verification of disability/medical documentation verifying functional limitations has not been received by SDRC **48 hours prior** to your appointment, the Intake appointment may need to be rescheduled.
  
- 4. Once accommodations and/or services are APPROVED by the Disability Specialist:**
  - ✓ Sign the Academic Accommodation Agreement form
  - ✓ Learn how to use your approved accommodations
  - ✓ Request Quarterly Accommodations via the R'Ability website
  - ✓ Send Faculty Accommodations Letters via the R'Ability website
  - ✓ Start using your approved accommodations
  
- 5. Each Quarter submit Quarterly Accommodations Request via R'Ability website:**
  - ✓ Request accommodations by course every quarter
  - ✓ Request updates to accommodations
  - ✓ Request that Letter of Accommodation be sent to course faculty
  
- 6. Follow up with a Disability Specialist for help** with questions on services available.
