

 - April 7th – June 5th
- Response Rate: **48%** (N=10,269 / 21,576)

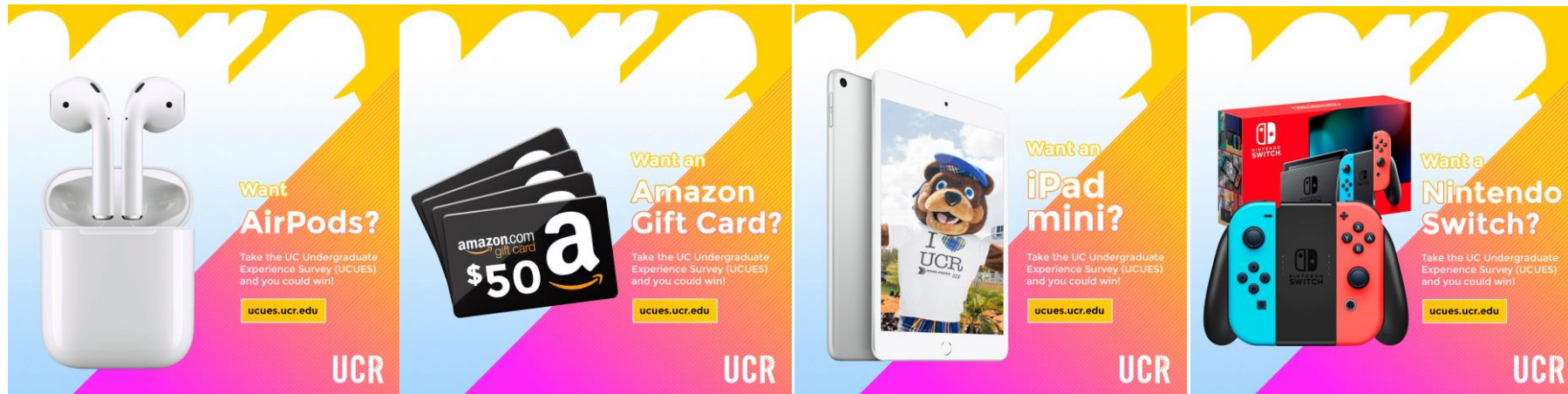

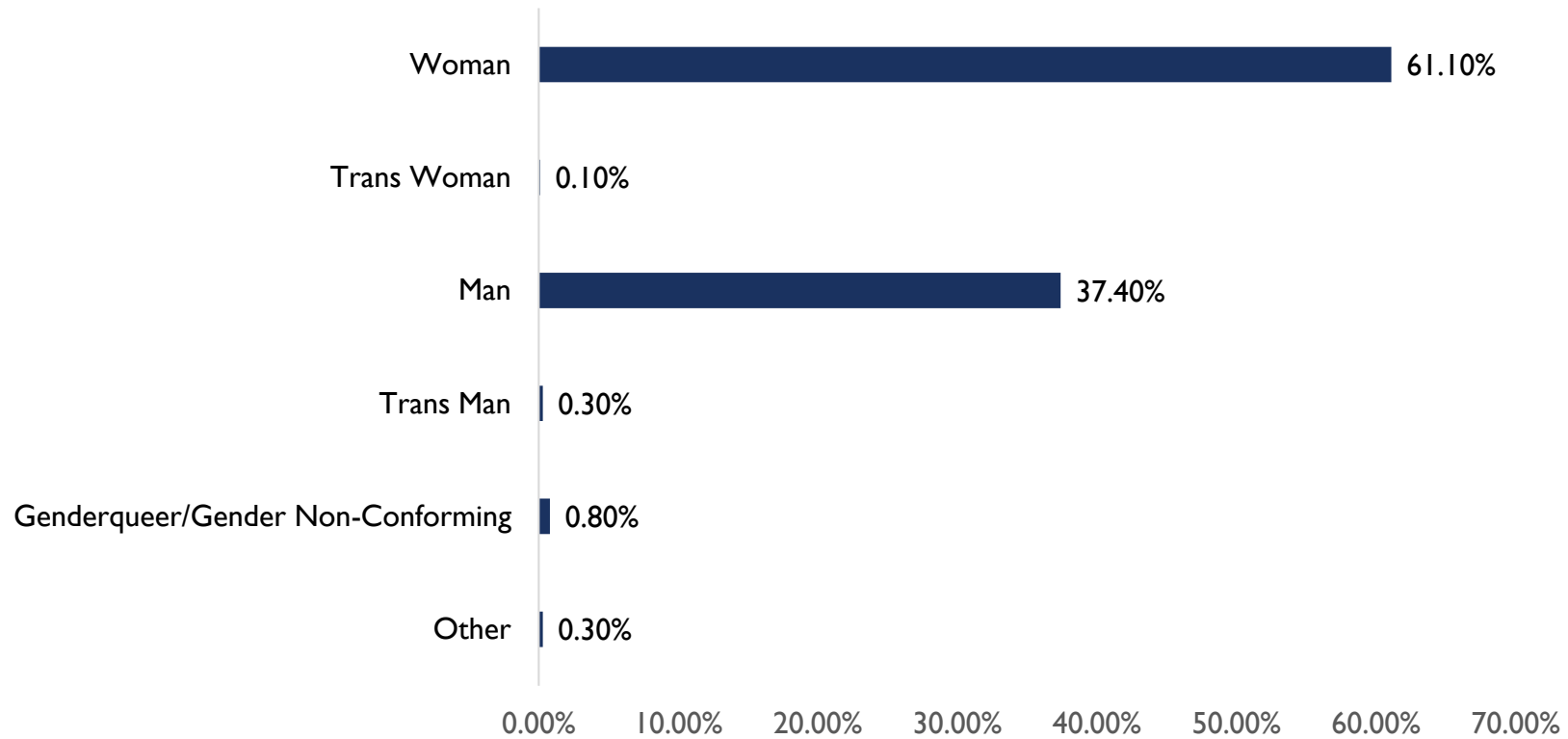

Gender Identity

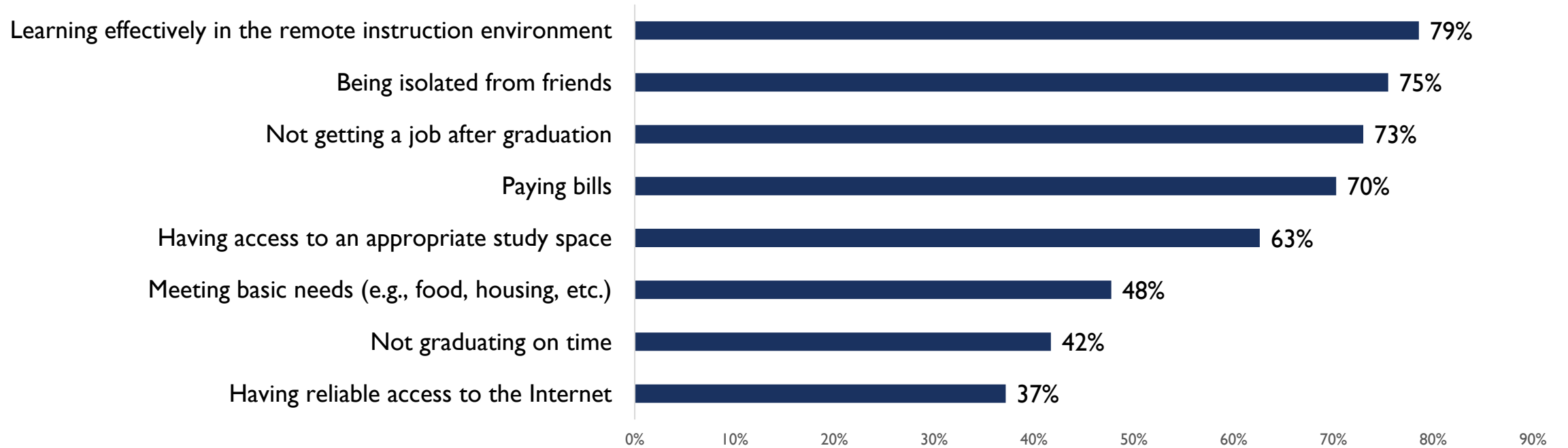

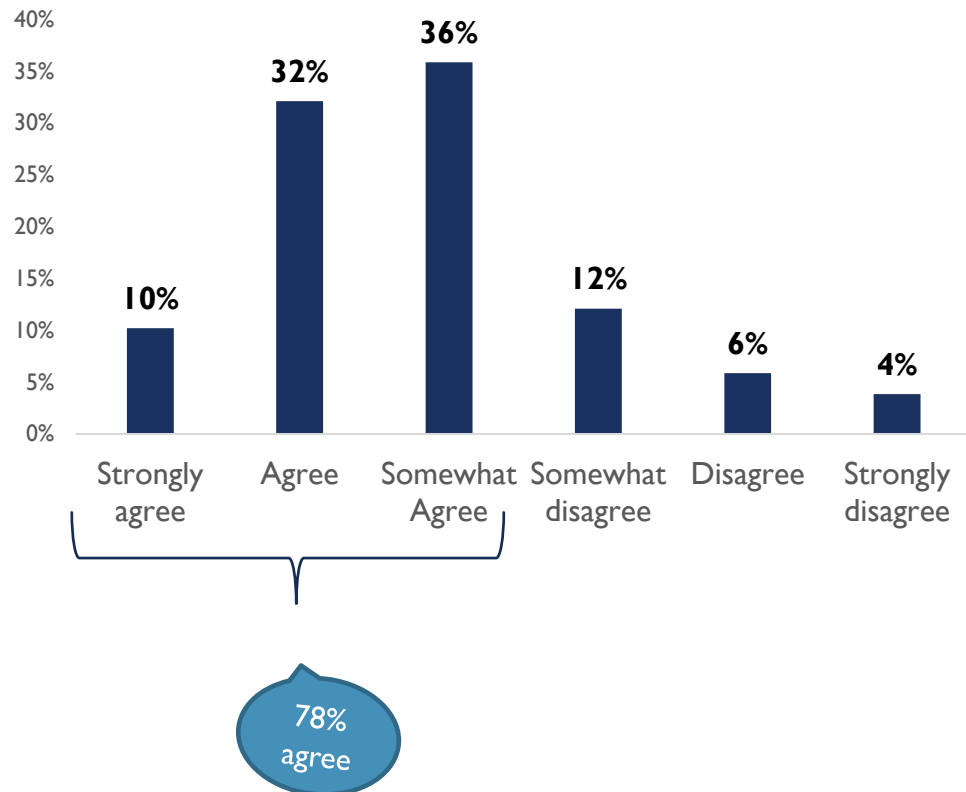
COVID-19: % Concerned



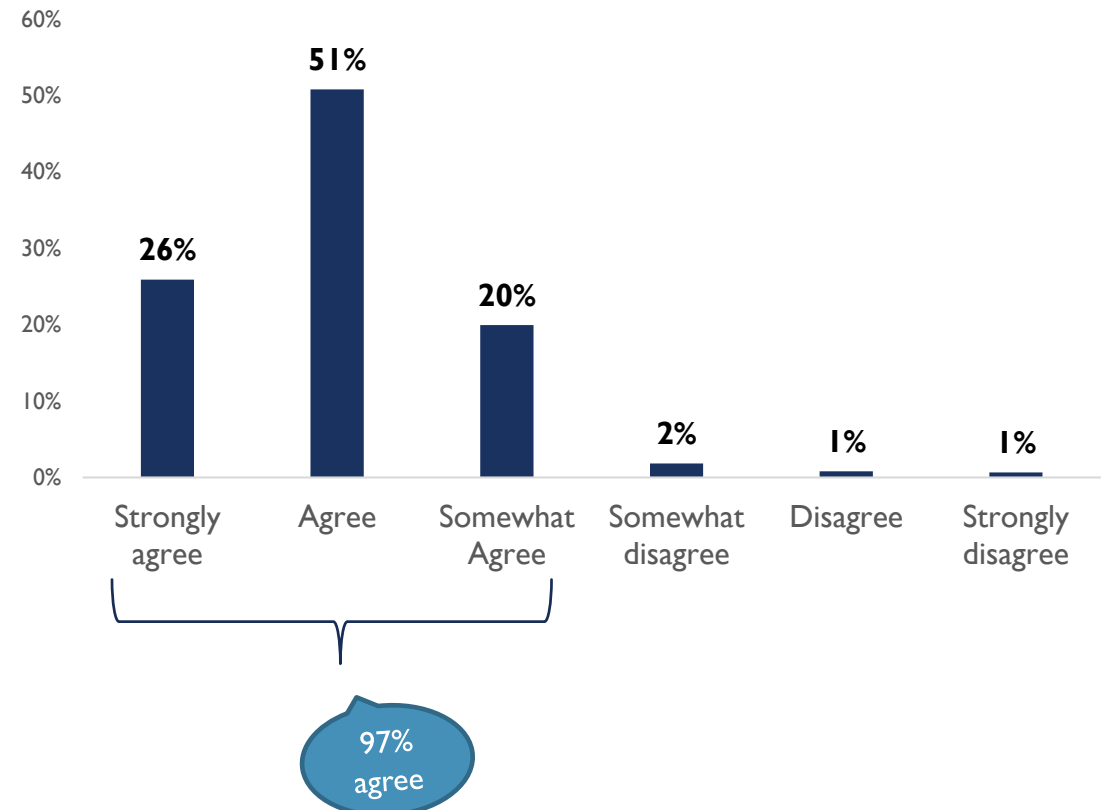

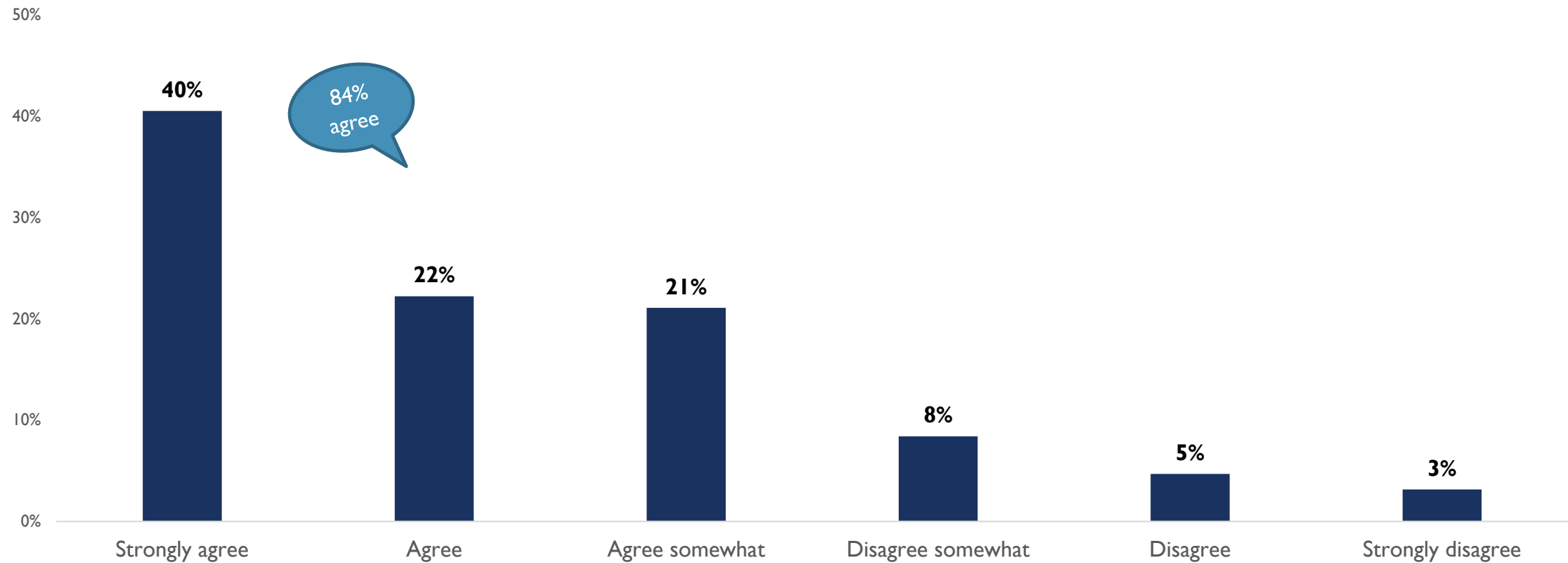

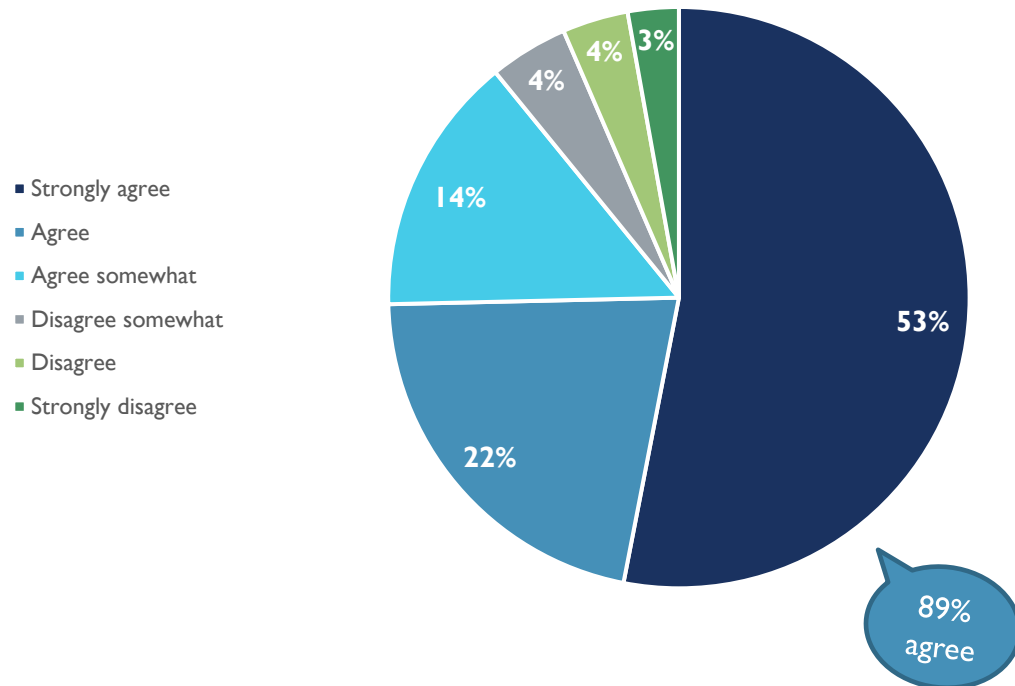
REMOTE LEARNING

"Remote learning is harder than learning in person."

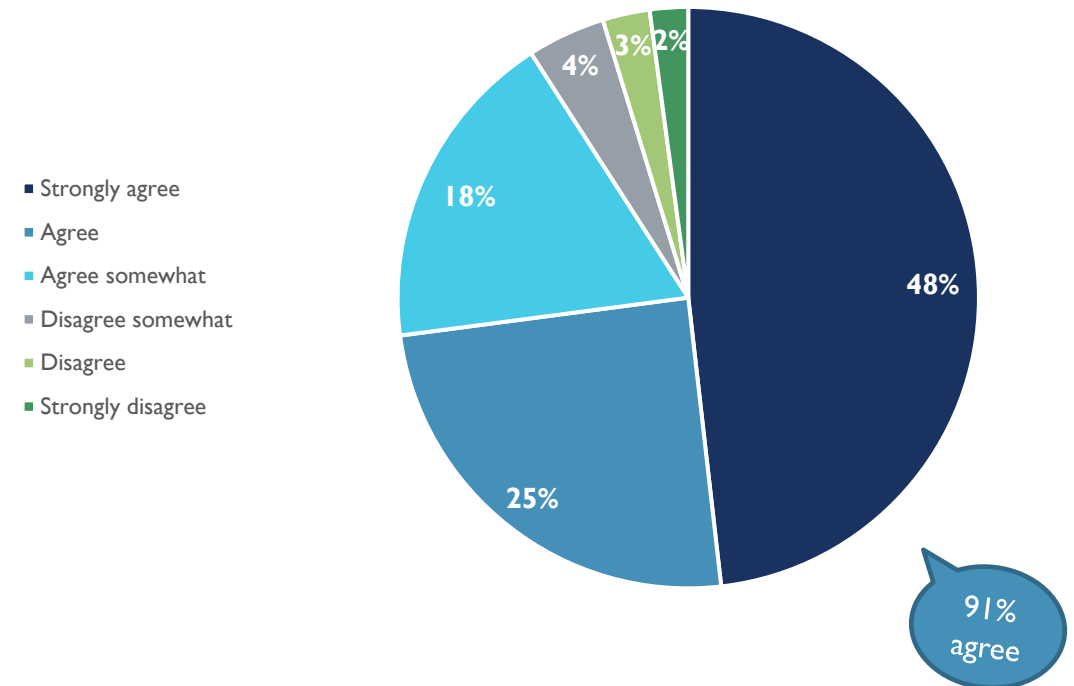

"I miss having access to on-campus social and cultural events."

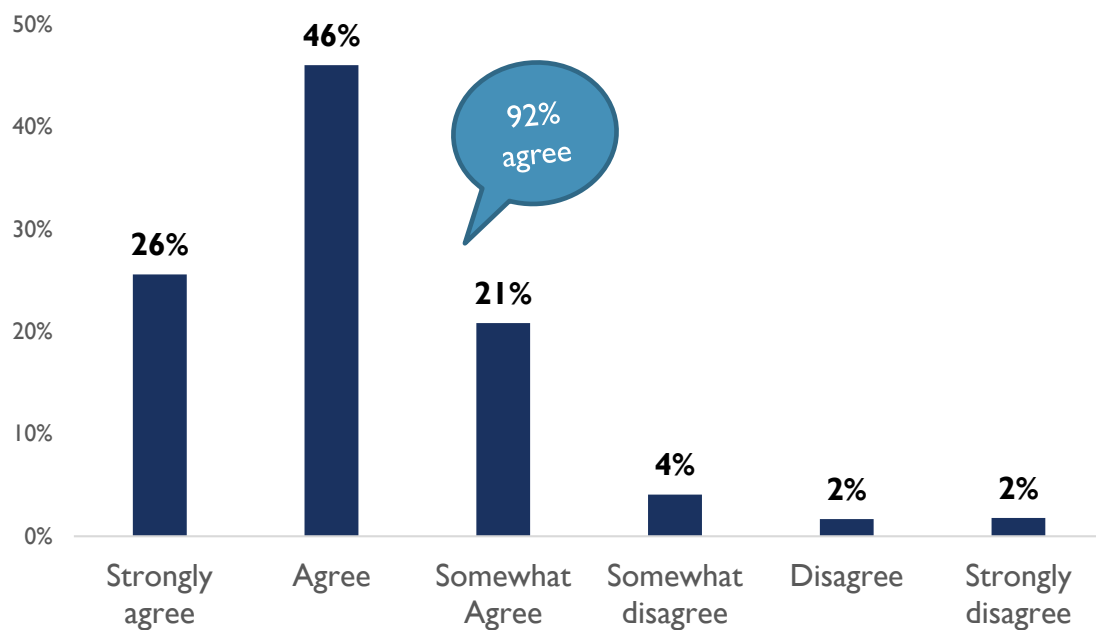


"I miss having access to on-campus resource centers."

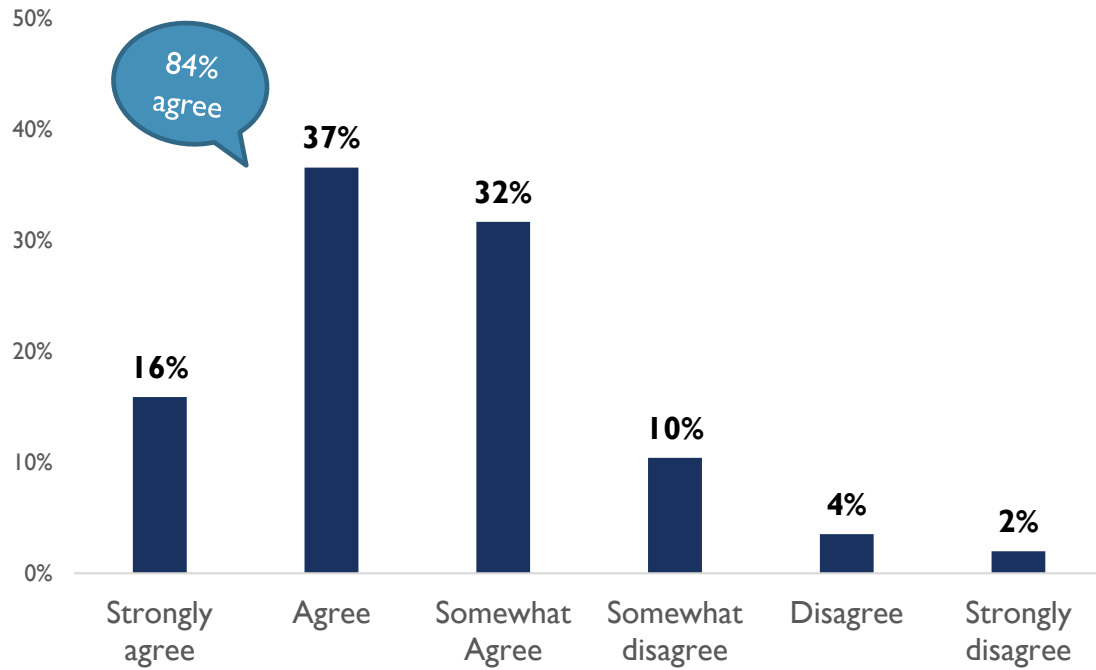

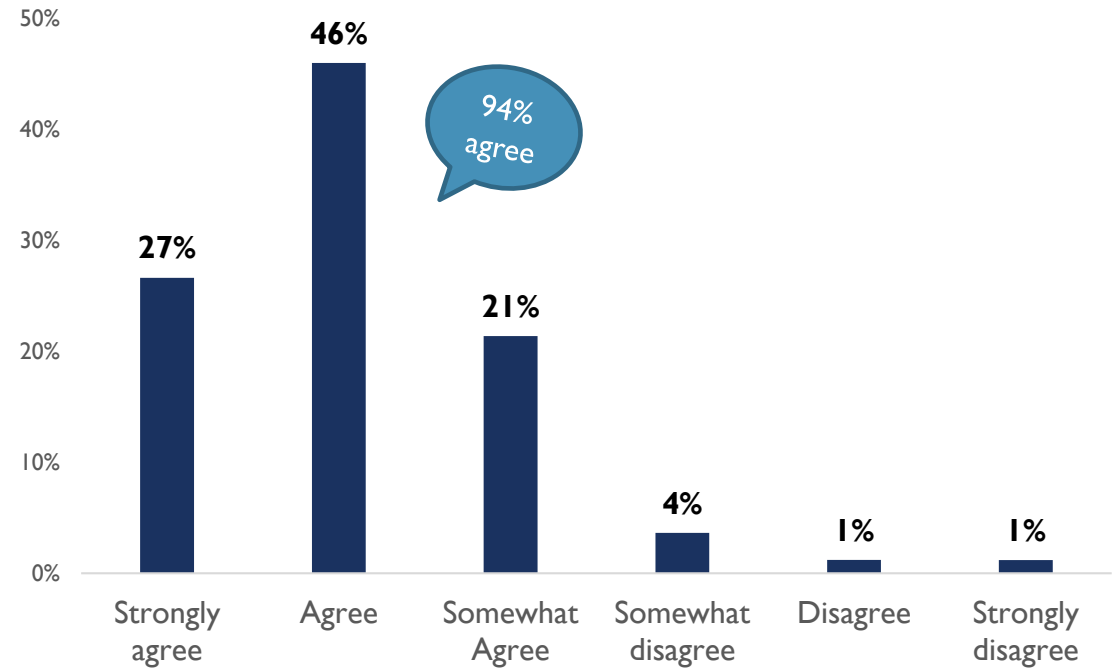

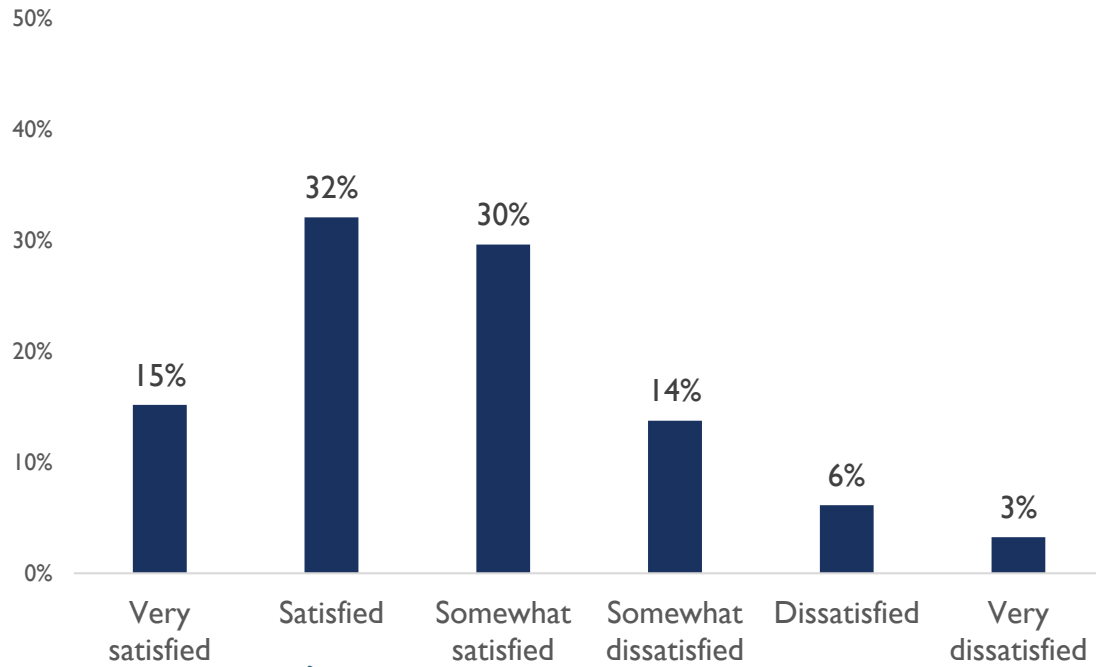

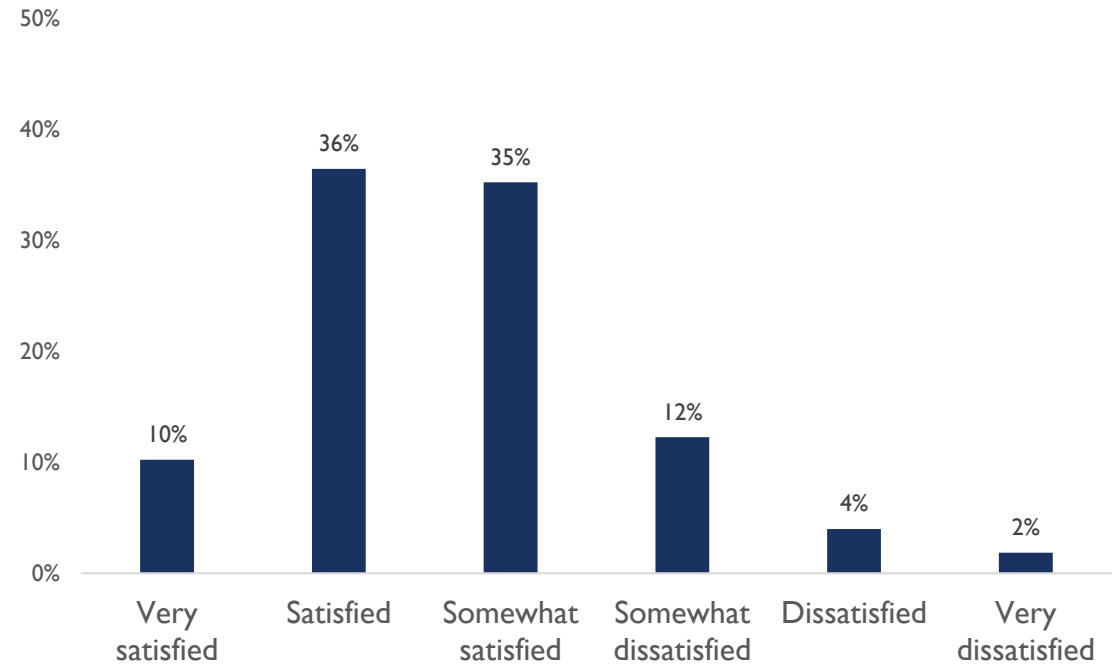

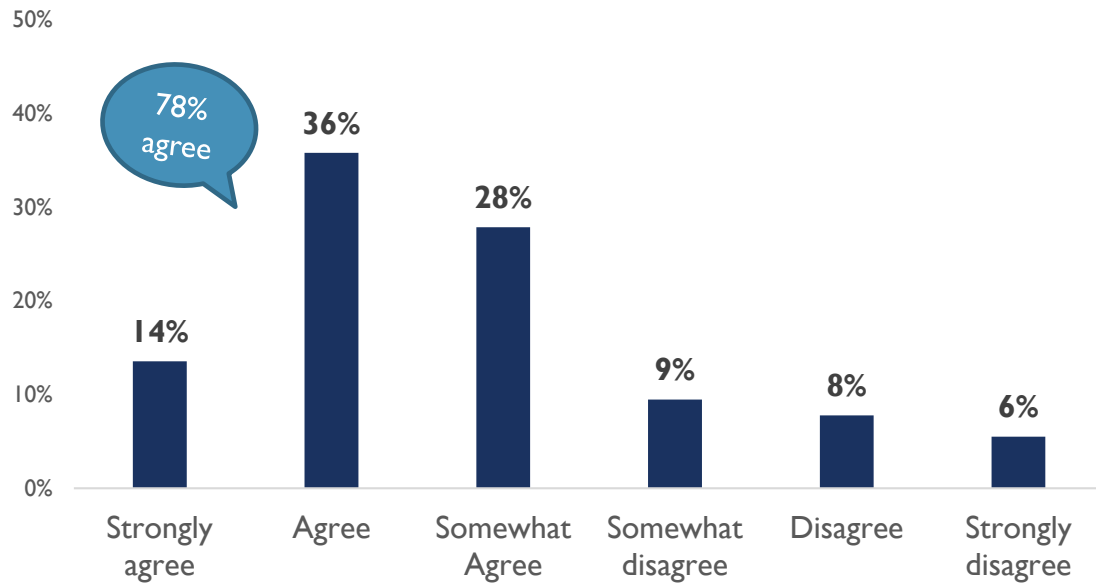
Satisfaction with Overall Academic Experience



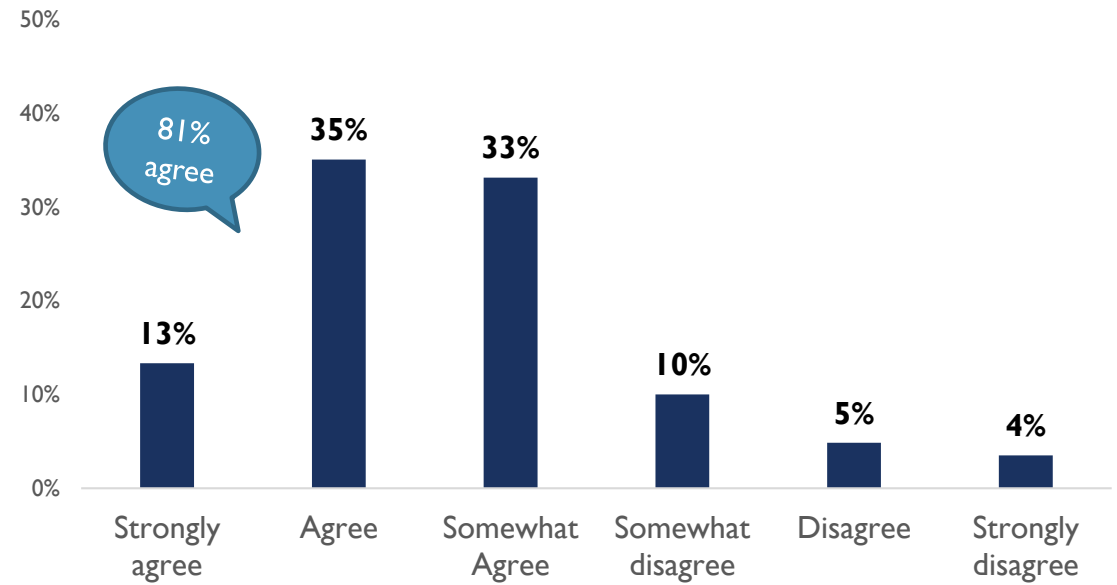

NEGATIVE STEREOTYPES

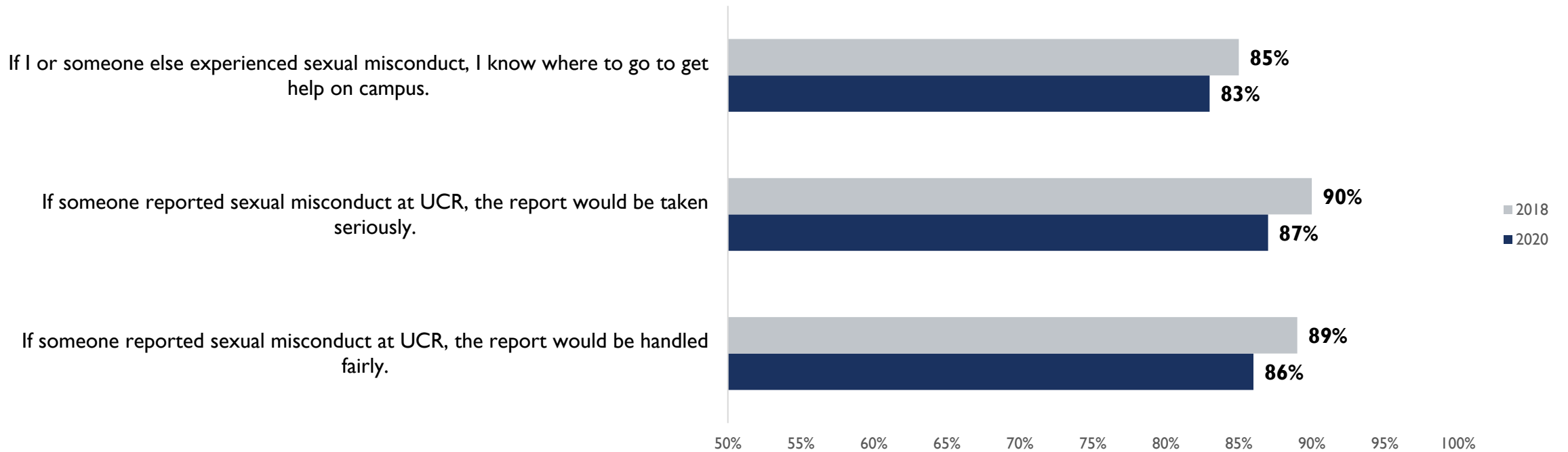

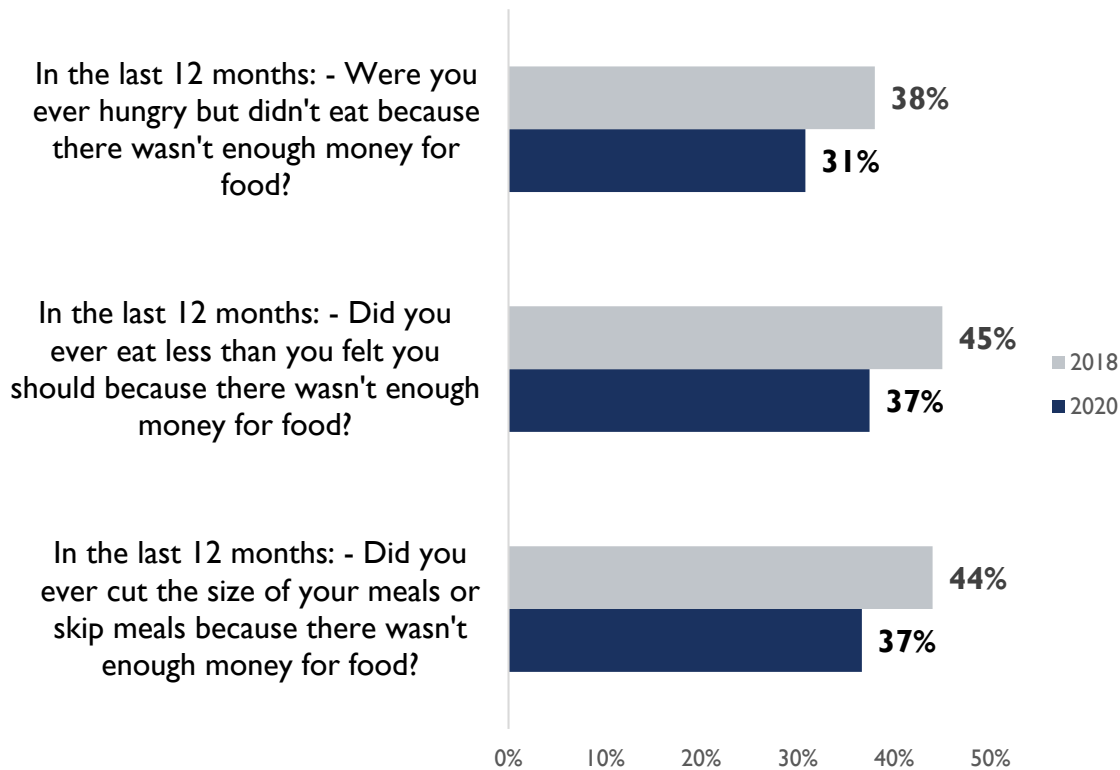
Sexual Misconduct: % Agree



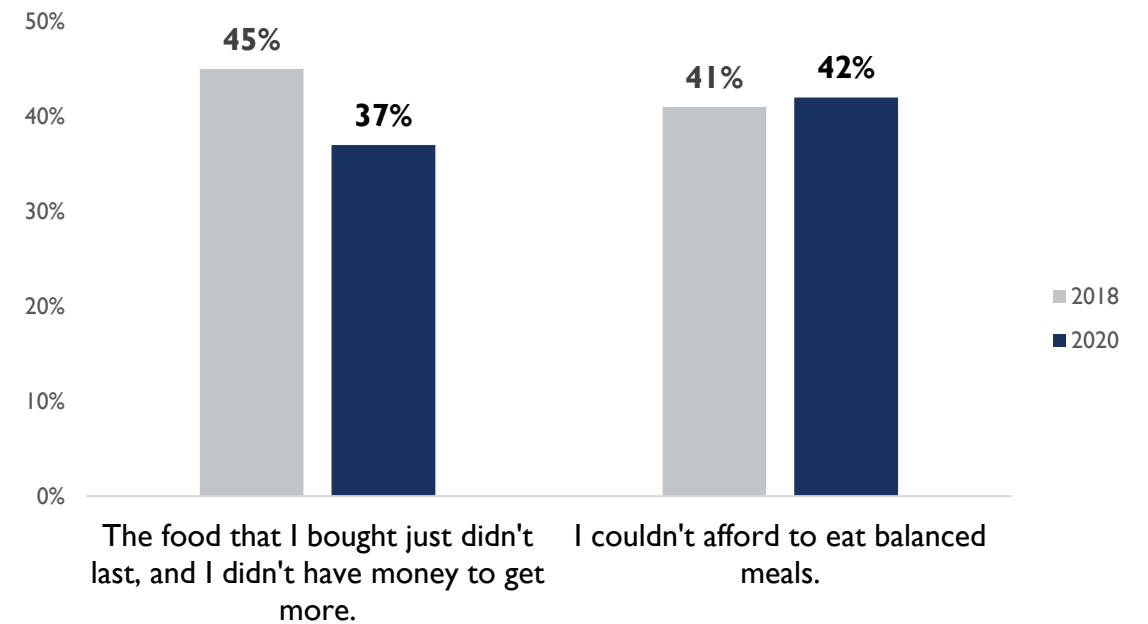

BASIC NEEDS: HOUSING INSECURITY

- **34** students indicated they had no stable residence/were homeless during Spring 2020
- **20** students slept overnight in an outdoor location
- **76** students temporarily lived at a hotel or motel without a permanent home to return to
- **131** students temporarily lived on campus in libraries, offices, or other non-residential university spaces
- **224** students slept overnight in a living room or another space not originally intended for habitation in a house or apartment
- **884** students temporarily stayed with a relative, friend, or couch surfed until they found other housing
- **387** students indicated that in the last 12 months, they were at risk of not having a safe, regular, and adequate nighttime place to stay and sleep while they were on the UC housing wait list
